The Pheasant Run Story-

The wines are ours... made by our own gentle hands (and feet). White Wines & Pinot Noir are grown in our Salmon-Safe certified Pheasant Run and Hot Rocks Vineyards- just a few miles outside of town. Our vineyards were full of pheasants when planted in the 1980s.

The Big Red Wines are made from fruit grown in premier vineyards in Walla Walla and beyond.

Cabernet, Merlot etc don't ripen here in the valley (yet.)

Our Tasting Room-

Originally part of the 1905 Portland World's Fair, it is made of cast concrete blocks that was high-tech at the time. It was dismantled and rebuilt here to become the town's bank. The vaults hold great stories that are all true!

The Aurora Colony

Aurora was settled as a "Utopian' Society in the 1850s.
The businesses (mill, hotel, stores) and lands (hops, fruit & hazelnuts) were owned by the community and everyone lived and worked together in harmony.
